

PURPOSE

Development of community resilience through circuits capable of enhancing territorial resources according to criteria of equity, environmental and socio-economic sustainability









SSED - Green economy- reuse and recycling





Promote the green economy as area of job placement for people in vulnerable situations.

9 centers for collecting and recycling run by social cooperatives

45 out of 77 employees are people in vulnerable situations + 40 volunteers

124t of assets managed in 2023

10.000€ to 20.000€ revenue per collecting center

Supporting local development through projects that envisage the introduction of new elements/measures in the areas concerned



30.000€ - 50.000€; 95%-co-finding
